

## Oswestry Games Parade 30<sup>th</sup> June

Risk Assessment - completed on 26 June 2012



- 1 We need a steward on the entrance to the car park to stop members of the public using it. Place a 'Road Closed' sign with a traffic cone.
- 2 Contact the Town Council to arrange for the park gates to be open that morning.
- 3 We need a sign at the Band Stand for parade registration/briefing.
- 4 Be careful not to trample the flowers at the entrance to the park.
- 5 Watch the guard at the base of the tree near the entrance to the park on the roadside - Trip hazard.
- 6 Stay on the pavement until the parade passes the road closure barrier.
- 7 Although the road is closed, be aware that cars that are parked on Church St, might decide to move off. Leave at least 1 metre space when walking past parked cars in case a car door is opened.
- 8 Stay on the pavement and be careful of street furniture and the kerbs as the parade turns left onto Leg St.
- 9 Beware of street furniture and the kerbs as the parade turns left onto Albion Hill. We need some barrier tape there to act as a guide for the parade route.
- 10 The market will be open (but thinning out by the time we get there at the top of Bailey St.)
- 11 Watch out for street furniture, cafe seating and sandwich boards on the way down Bailey St.
- 12 Turn left back onto Cross St and gather for the dance performance.
- 13 Be careful of traffic on Church Street after the parade disperses.
- 14 General - Be very careful with bats, swords. No fencing in the street. No collections of money. Please hand out leaflets.
- 15 Be polite, wave and smile. We are sharing the streets with the public.
- 16 The police are aware that the parade is taking place and will be in the area.
- 17 There is no first aid cover for this parade, in the event of an emergency, dial 999.
- 18 All of the shops on the route of the parade have been leafleted to inform them of the parade.
